witnesseth That the aforesaid Mills for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars in hand paid by the aforesaid Falkner the receipt of which he hath hereby acknowledged and him self therewith fully satisfied hath bargained and sold unto the aforesaid Falkner a certain tract or parcel of Land situate in the County aforesaid on Little Richland creek and bounded as follows. Beginning at a Hickory in ^{the} South boundary line of said Falkners original tract and about thirty poles East of a Branch of said Little Richland creek running South one hundred and twenty-two poles crossing said creek at one hundred poles to three Maples. Thence West sixty seven poles to a Chestnut and Hickory. Thence North one hundred and twenty two poles to a Black-gum Thence East sixty seven poles to the beginning containing fifty one acres.
